
Wired for Working From Home

The four Cs

Home Hub Installations will wire your home during the build, so that all the wires are completely concealed. The infrastructure is essentially the four Cs: coax cable, Cat6 cables, connections and a cabinet.

Coax (coaxial) is the cable that carries the television signal from your aerial, satellite dish or cable box. It's wired to every room in the house to give you total flexibility, now and in the future, for where you'd like to watch TV.

Cat6 (Category 6 HDBT) is a versatile network cable that carries data around your home. It's used for a great many things, from super-fast broadband in every room to HDMI high definition video distribution to carrying the picture from CCTV security cameras.

Cabinet is the name for the place where all these cables come together. It's the heart of your system. We'll happily explain how all of this works, or if you just want seamless home entertainment, we won't bore you with the details. The cabinet is hidden out of sight, typically in an under-stairs cupboard. All the equipment that serves your Smart home, for example your router, a satellite or cable box, Blu-ray player and games consoles can be put in the cabinet but they can be enjoyed anywhere in the home.

Connections. Your devices can be connected at faceplates in every room. These faceplates have internet connections which can also be used to share printers and files such as music, photos or video. The faceplates also have coaxial connection points which are used to connect and share TV services and devices such as Virgin Media, Freeview, Sky+, Sky+HD, Freesat and Blu Ray.

Services

The system works with any phone, TV and broadband provider. So your cabinet might be home to a box for Sky, Virgin Media, BT, Freesat, Freeview or another service. You'll have just one box, located centrally, but you can enjoy the content in any room in the house, along with music, movies and DAB / FM radio.

Speed

Your wired network can handle speeds of up to 10,000mbps, which is blistering compared with Wi-Fi speeds. This means it's fast enough to make the most of new fibre optic broadband and will keep pace with new, faster technologies as they come along. Depending on your ISP, even your Wi-Fi will be faster than before for the simple reason that you will use wires for most jobs.
